Ca. 500 affiliated libraries in 31 Institutions


1. Introduction

SLSP's role in the swisscovery Network:

- Service provider for the ca. 500 libraries
- Coordination
- Representing the network in IGeLU (International Group of Ex Libris Users)
 Working Groups and/or Early Adopter programs
- Driving forward enhancements
- Various projects (e.g. migrations, developing new services, UX, ...)
- 1st level support (2nd level support by Ex Libris)





SLSP's role in the field of preservation and digitization:

- Improving the access and discoverability of cultural material:
 - e.g. guidelines for integration of institutional repositories
 - establishing common standards
 - enhancement and development in collaboration with Ex Libris
 - constantly improving the user experience
- No digitization or preservation project conducted by SLSP
 - evaluating improvement of metadata (PIDs etc.)
 - establishing rules for cataloguing




Offering a repository: Digital material loaded in Alma


- Digital objects loaded in Alma (exceeding 1 TB), collections with images, audio/visual material
- Exposed via Alma Viewer and discovery collections in swisscovery

Being an aggregator: Digital material harvested directly in swisscovery

- Over 2 Mio records from institutional repositories: Approx. 60 shared with the network
- Many expose heritage collections: ecodices, e-manuscripta, Fri-Memoria, Zbcollections, ETH Hochschularchiv


Example of Central Library Zurich via Alma Viewer








<u>Presentation of inventory</u> <u>in a discovery collection</u>

Measures to validate heritage collections in swisscovery by...

Definition of standard for all SLSP libraries

- Established "Master Template" applicable to all SLSP libraries → consistency
- Incorporating heritage data with local fields for display and search in addition to the <u>OTB-mapping by Ex Libris</u>
- Details available on GitHub: <u>Swiss Library Service Platform</u>

Measures to validate heritage collections in swisscovery by...

Definition of standard for all SLSP libraries

- Exclusion of archival material, maps and musicalia from FRBR + Dedup
- Mapping for external data imported from repositories ensured by the institutions and SLSP
- Inclusion of additional local resource types in addition to the ones <u>OTB</u>:
 - 3D Models (e.g., ETH's antique astronomic instruments)
 - Correspondence
 - Microform
 - Collection object

3. Service 'SLSP Bibliographies'

SLSP Bibliographies



Purpose

- Views which provide bibliographical references only, while regular swisscovery views are focusing on delivery services
- Views serving as a display window for collections on specific topics or geographical areas
- Offering more flexibility than in the regular swisscovery views and the SLSP standard



RecherchePatrimoniale

Purpose:

- Display window showcasing offerings of Swiss libraries*
- Feasibility study for merging titles from different Alma environments
- Synergies between SLSP and non-SLSP-members

Project:

- Result of collaboration between SLSP and Swiss National Library starting May 2023
- Launched December 2023
- Searchable holdings of over 500 academic libraries from swisscovery and SNL



Configuration:

- data from Helveticat harvested into Primo of SLSP Network Zone
- data excluded as results from search in regular swisscovery views
- Only one search profile

UI customization:

- removed "My Account" + Login option
- removed delivery services, only keeping links to re-direct
- Design of start page, logo, favicon



Impact

- Visibility and political significance of the project
- Display window showcasing offerings of Swiss libraries

Branding and Communication





- Unique branding, name, logo, and look for the RP view
- Communication within the network and externally

Challenges

- Usability issues solved by Ex Libris: Blank search after 2nd authentication in swisscovery
- Limitation of external data which can be excluded from regular searches

Future Integration?

- More patrimonial libraries in the Recherche Patrimoniale view
- Investigating integration of patrimonial libraries into SLSP Network

5. Patrimonial libraries and SLSP



Aspects to be checked for future collaboration:

- Patrimonial collections
 - Patrimonial libraries differ primarily from public and academic libraries
 - required by law to preserve and make available certain collections
- Metadata / Data sovereignty
 - bibliographical metadata itself can belong to the cultural patrimony
 - in the swisscovery network, catalogue data can be modified by everyone
- Interfaces APIs to external data sources and systems

5. Patrimonial libraries and SLSP



Aspects to be checked for future collaboration:

- User data
 - swisscovery users are connected via Switch edu-ID, but in cantonal libraries, there are also pupils and elder people part of the users
 - Legal aspects to be clarified
- Terms of use
 - Several cantonal libraries have terms of use differing from the ones used by the SLSP network where all terms of use are harmonized

5. Outlook



Challenges:

- External data which cannot be excluded from regular search to be solved in future
- Digital objects to be shared among the network without DO from IZ X becoming part of local scope of IZ Y - ExL is working on this



Future collaborations:

More collaborations on national or international level by harvesting data and exposing in special views (regional / thematic) and/or integration in the regular swisscovery views (see the example 'Connectome')
