# Prudenci & Aurora Bertrana Special Collection


- Source: Diputació de Girona, Enric Sabadell, Família Guitart, Montserrat Cosidó, Víctor Compte

- 1200 books (mainly literature in Catalan, Spanish, French, English, etc.)
- Archival material:
  - Manuscripts of literary works (some unpublished)
  - Newspaper clippings and personal documents
  - Letters
  - Photographs and drawings



## Who was Prudenci Bertrana?



- Tordera, 1867 Barcelona, 1941
- Writer, journalist, theatre critic and painter
- Expelled from Girona after a polemical article, he moved to Barcelona
- Modernist, anti-intellectual attitude
- Works:
  - o Josafat (1906)
  - o Nàufrags (1907)
  - o L'Hereu (1931)
  - o El vagabund (1933)
  - L'Impenitent (1948)
- Magazines & Newspapers:
  - La Veu de Catalunya
  - L'Esquella de la Torratxa
  - o El Poble català
  - La Publicidad

### Who was Aurora Bertrana?



- Girona, 1892 Berga, 1974
- Writer and musician
- She studies violoncello in Girona, Barcelona, Suiza
- She creates a women jazz trio in Switzerland
- She changes music for literature
- She spends 4 years in French Polynesia
- She takes part in 1933 election with ERC party
- She is exiled from 1936 until 1950
- Works:
  - o Paradisos oceànics (1930)
  - o El Marroc sensual i fanàtic (1936)
  - o Entre dos silencis (1958)
  - Vent de grop (1967)
  - Memòries (ed. Conjunta en 2013)

# Bertrana de Capçalera: aims and methodology

Project Aims



- Create a useful tool for researchers
- Promote both autors, their production and their special collection

Work Methodology



- Search in bibliographies, publications and academic works
- Search in journals and newspapers were they used to publish
- Study of the article clippings and manuscipts included in the special collection
- Weekly meetings for discussion and updates



# Bertrana de Capçalera: technical infrastructure (the background)

- Web explorer
- Single table
- Search and filters
- Template with fields
- Multiple users

#### Work frame:

- RapidApp (Perl + Ajax + ExtJs 3.0)
- Model view-controller
- Extensible

Database Sqlite + C language

#### Work roles:

- Admin
- Editor
- User

#### Functionality:

Local information export

# Bertrana de Capçalera: web interface (the front-end)

- REST API with Javascript, Jquery and Jquery Tables
- Display in two diferent tables
- Fields:
  - Title
  - Publication Year
  - o Date
  - Publication
  - Number and Pages
  - o Serial
- Sort and Filter
- Link to fulltext
- Information retrieval from other remote information systems




# Bertrana de Capçalera: first results

- Header: branding and attractive design
- Total articles compiled after launching:
  - o Prudenci: 1509
  - o Aurora: 148
- Collaborative and horitzontal working model
- Several academic Works using Bertrana de Capçalera
- Future challenge: keep growing and compile 100% of articles
